Immanuel's Relocation: It is our prayer that each need will be filled through the help of our families, extended families, alumni and friends. Parents will receive notification this coming week in your email inbox from Sign-Up Genius about Relocation Needs on a sign-up sheet where you can register your commitment to help with this event. You can also find a list of dates and the tasks scheduled for those days posted in the school office.

Month of May: Volunteers to assist staff members with sorting items in preparation for relocating. Availability can be during the day or after school.

Saturday, May 27 8 AM–2 PM: A Work-Bee (sorting party) to bring boxes to designated areas. Child care will be provided by the school at Whitby Free Methodist church from 8 AM until 2 PM (just down the road from the school).

May 27th to June 9th: 2-4 people to organize, advertise and manage an onsite moving sale for Saturday, June 3. Childcare will again be provided by the school at Whitby Free Methodist church from 8 AM until 2 PM.

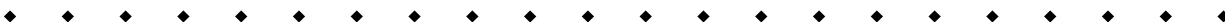

Bus Transportation: Please call Phoenix Transportation (905-697-0503), by 7:00 AM if your child will not be taking the bus to school. Give the Bus route (701-Immanuel), your child(ren)'s name(s) and bus stop location. If your child is not taking the bus home you must inform the school office by 3 p.m. to avoid confusion.

School Dismissal: Students not picked up by a parent/caregiver by 3:40 p.m. will automatically be enrolled into the Before and After School Care and the parents will be billed accordingly. The fee is to be paid by purchasing a card or exact change upon pickup.



Club MED (Before & After School Care) is available from 7:00 - 8:35 AM and from 3:30 - 6:00 PM Monday to Friday. The cost for 1 child is \$6, \$7.50 for 2 children and \$9 for 3 children per half hour. Cards must be prepaid and include 10 hours of service, 1 child \$120, 2 children \$150 and three children is \$180.



Immanuel is "Peanut-Free." An ICS staff member is highly allergic and cannot be in the same room as peanuts and avoids all other nuts as well. We ask parents to comply with these guidelines ensuring your child's snack and lunch are peanut-free.
